## Internal Pilot

- Finished 26 September 2023
  - T4P has been open for 12 months of recruitment
  - NIHR will look at sites open, recruitment, and adherence at first procedure

## Sites and Recruitment

- 39 sites open – aim was 66 by this time, but difficult to get open post-COVID (strikes, capacity)
- 182 patients randomised, which makes us the largest study on prophylactic platelet transfusions in ICU in the UK!
- We are currently behind our NIHR targets, but know you are all working hard, and ICU admissions are low currently.
