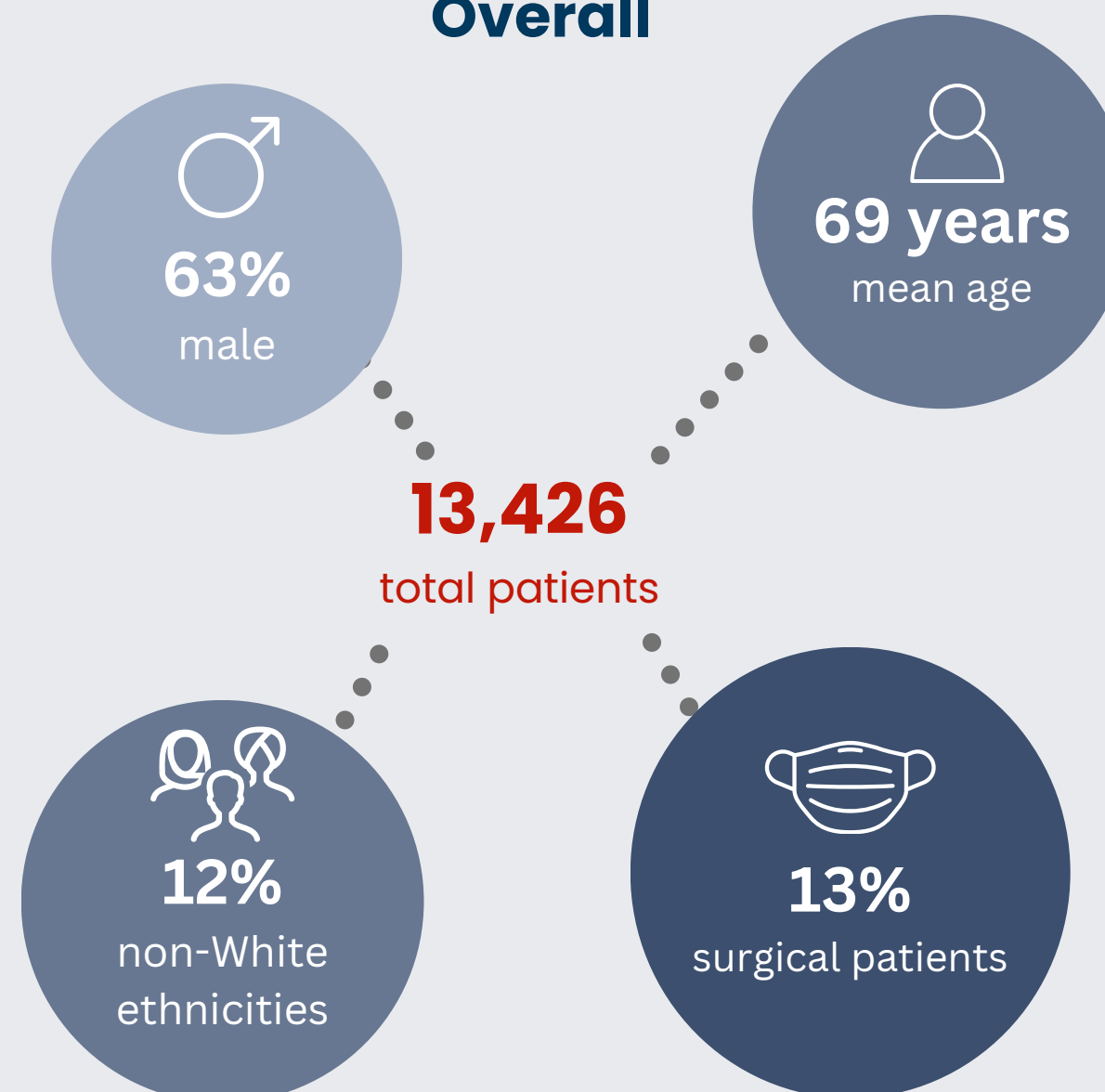

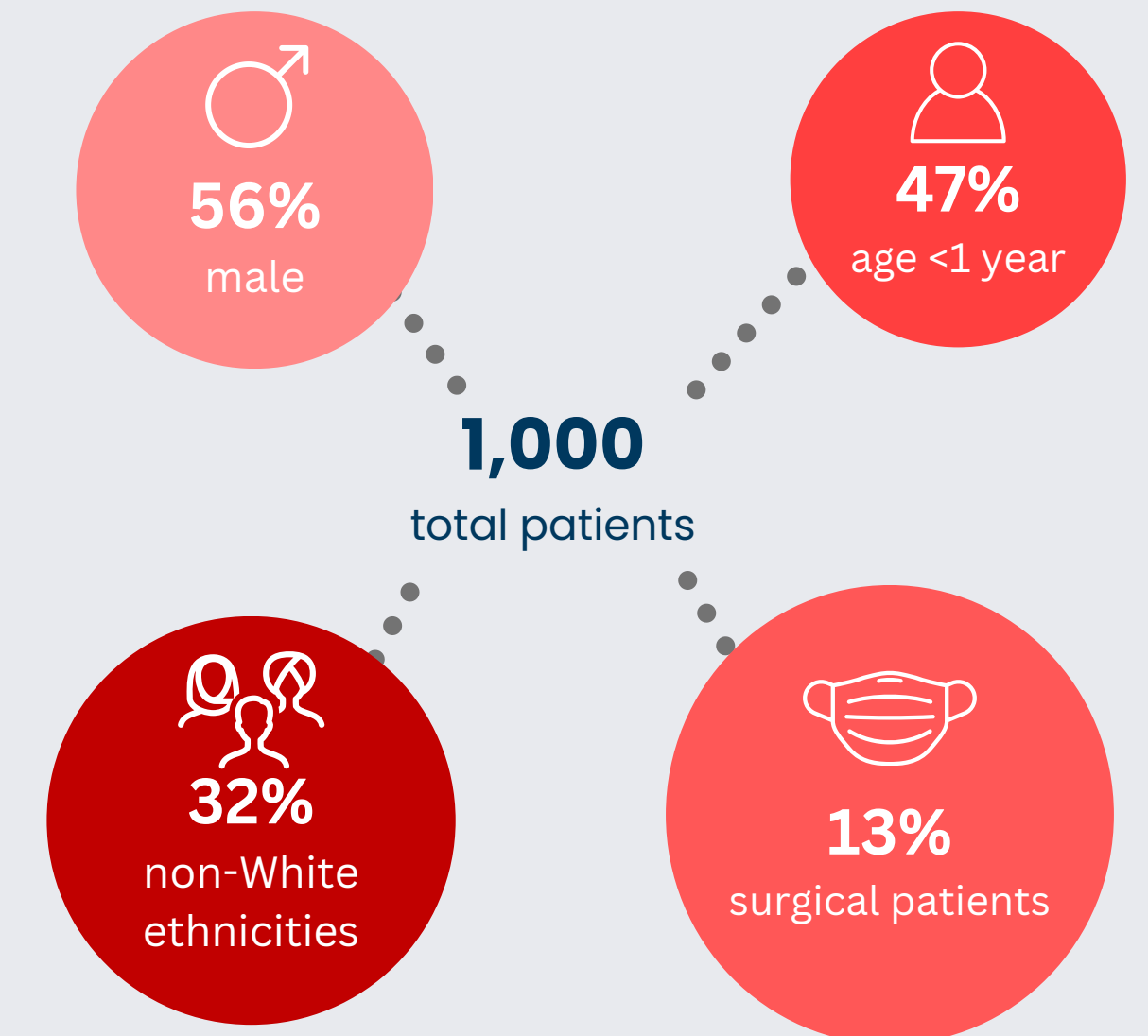

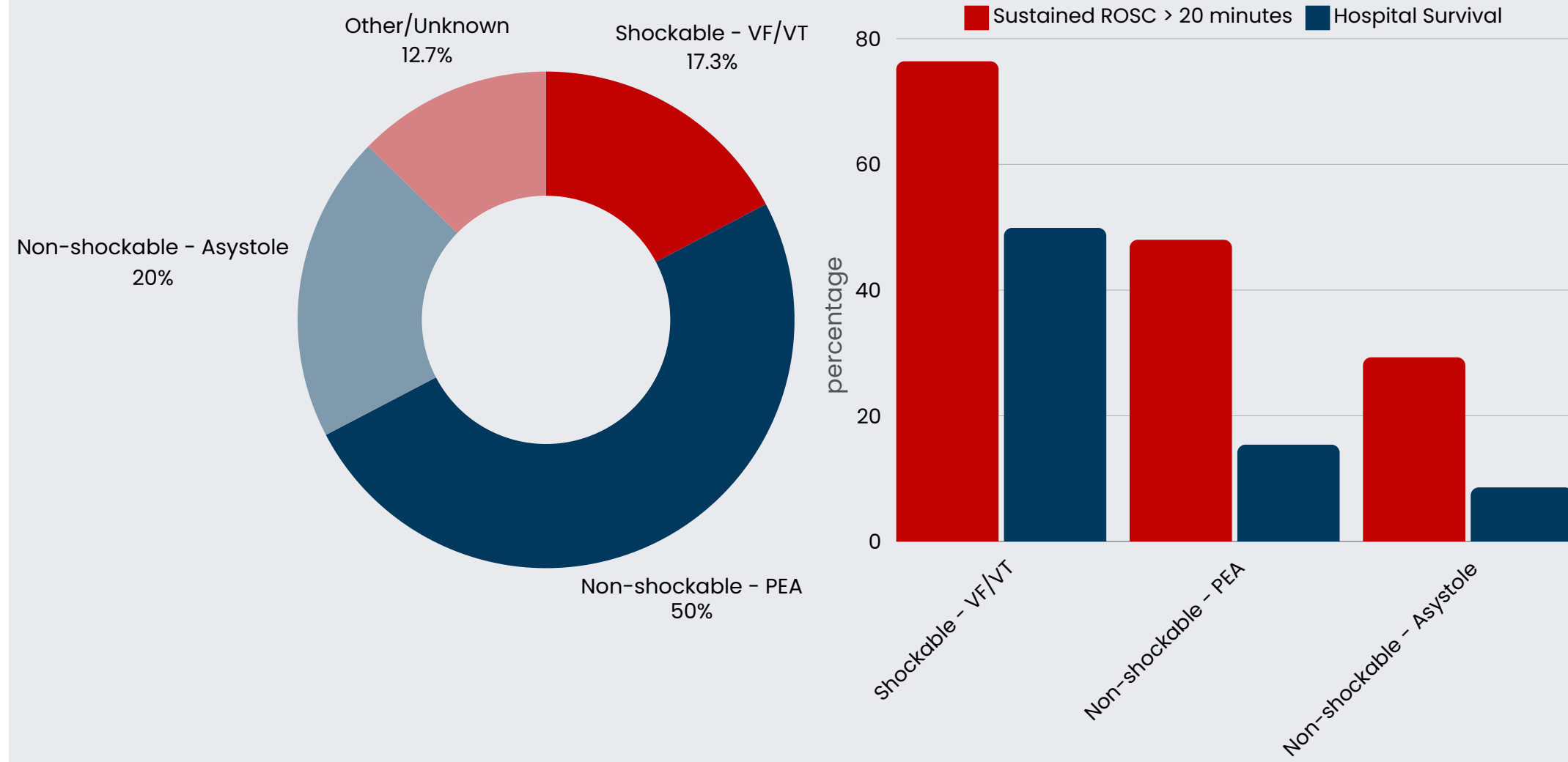

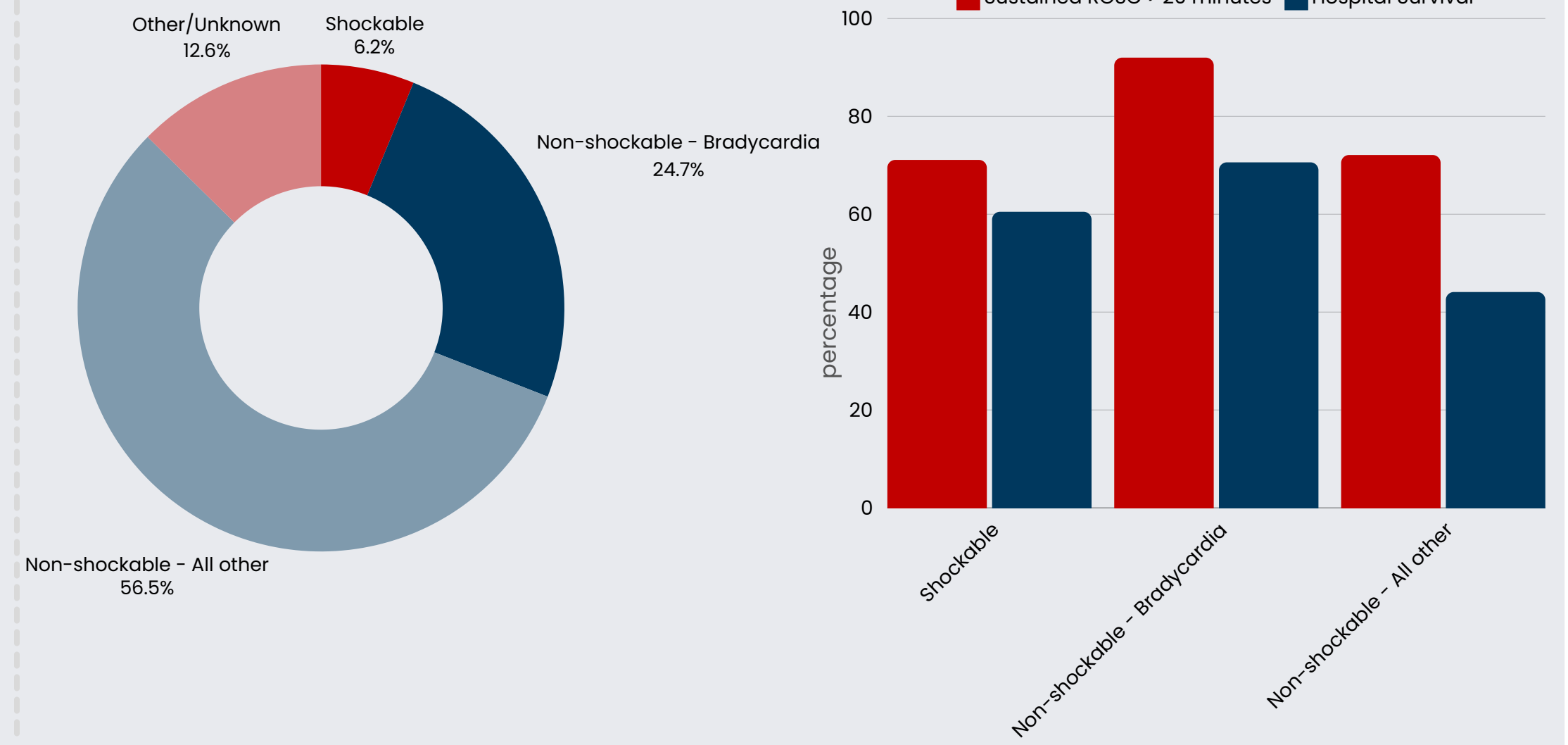


Outcomes by rhythm

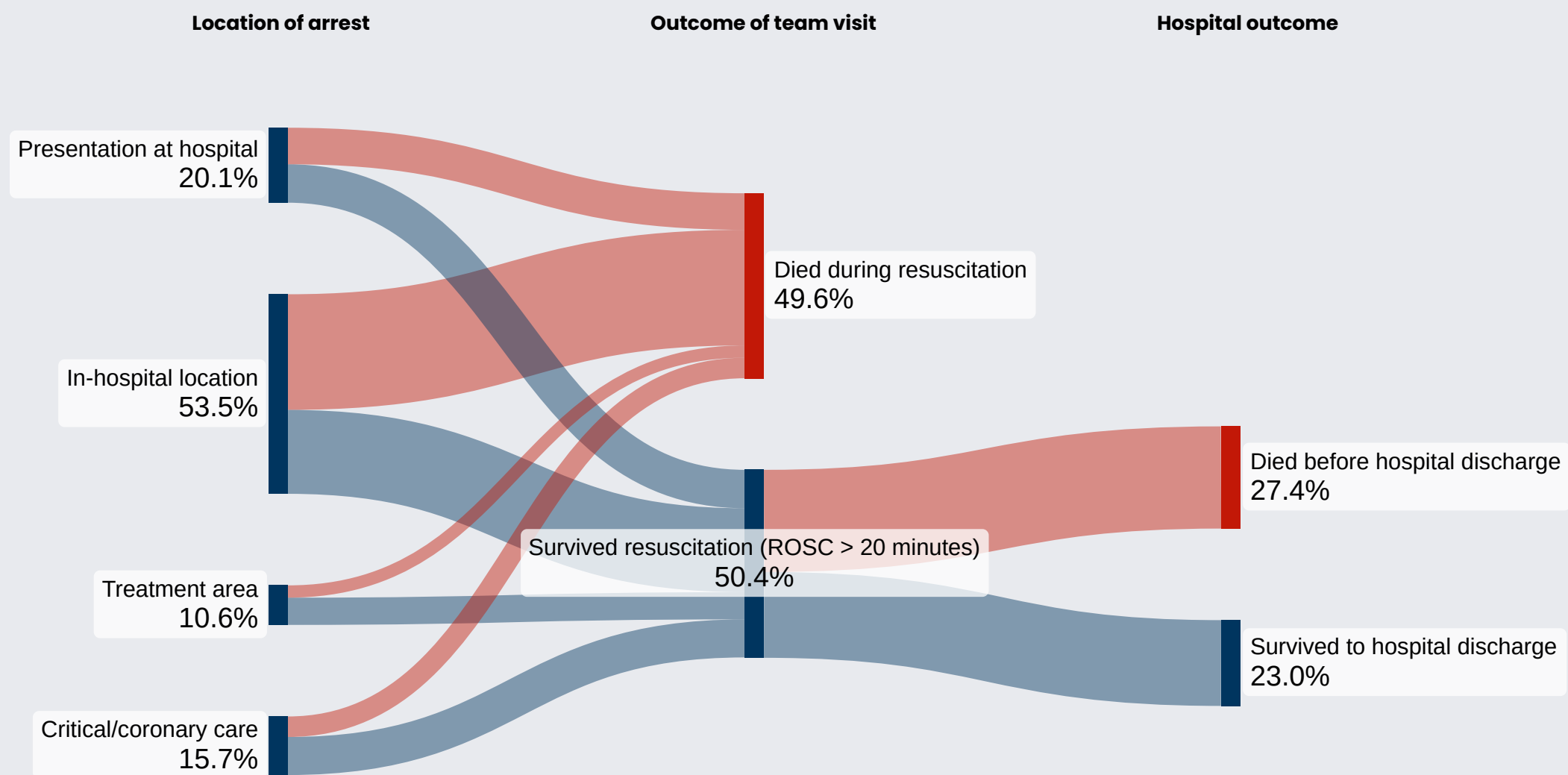
